

## **OUC and SARCCM meeting at Laoshan campus on 27 October 2014**

Ocean University of China (OUC) Vice President Ju Yan met with Assoc. Prof. Xiao Hua Wang, Director of Sino-Australian Research Centre for Coastal Management (SARCCM), at OUC's Laoshan campus on 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2014. Assoc. Prof. Wang introduced recent achievements in Jiaozhou Bay research projects, including eight publications in a SI of *Estuarine, Coastal and Shelf Science* entitled 'Impact on coasts and their ecosystems in the Yellow and East China Sea by intensive anthropogenic activities'; establishment of the World Harbour Project in partnership with SIMS, establishment of the Jiaozhou Bay Institute for Coastal Management (JIM) and convening of three workshops with a cross-disciplinary research team.
