



Prof. Yongming JIN is a Doctor of Law and Postdoctoral in Theoretical Economics. Currently, he is a professor and doctoral supervisor of the School of International Affairs and Public Administration in Ocean University of China, and director of Sino-Australian Research Consortium for Coastal Management (Chinese side). He used to be a researcher at the Shanghai Academy of Social Sciences Institute of Law. He has been a visiting scholar and researcher in the Ocean Policy Research Institute of Sasakawa Peace Foundation, Law Academy of Waseda University, and Graduate Schools for Law and Politics of Tokyo University.

Prof. Jin also serves as a director of the Chinese Society of International Law, a standing director of Chinese Association for Japanese Studies, a standing director of China Association of Marine Affairs, a director of the Marine Strategy Research Office in Academy of Ocean of China, a vice president of Shanghai Association for Japanese Studies, a vice president of Shanghai Institute for International Strategic Studies.

Prof. Jin has published more than 80 journal papers, over 200 reports, and 11 books on issues related to the law of the sea. Prof. Jin also has presided over and completed 15 research projects at or above the provincial and ministerial level related to marine issues and the law of the sea.
